Phase 2: Accomplishments

2011 - 2016

The University has successfully completed all projects identified in Phase 2. Phase 2 included a wide range of renovation projects, new construction, open space, and infrastructure projects.

Major new renovation projects included The ARCH, Tse Center, Meyerson Hall, Van Pelt Library, and Hill College House.

Major new construction projects included several academic, research, housing and support facilities. Major new academic facilities included Singh Center for Nanotechnology, Golkin Hall, Stephen A. Levin Building, and the Mack Pavilion. New clinical and clinical support facilities included the Smilow Center for Translational Research and the Penn Presbyterian Pavilion for Advanced Care. New housing facilities included the New College House at Hill Square, and apartments at 40th and Pine streets, and at 40th and Chestnut streets. Infrastructure facilities included the Module 7 Chiller expansion.

Open space and streetscape improvement projects included Shoemaker Green, Penn Park, Kane Park, Locust Walk, the Generation Bridge, Walnut Street between 32nd and 33rd streets, and portions of Locust Walk.

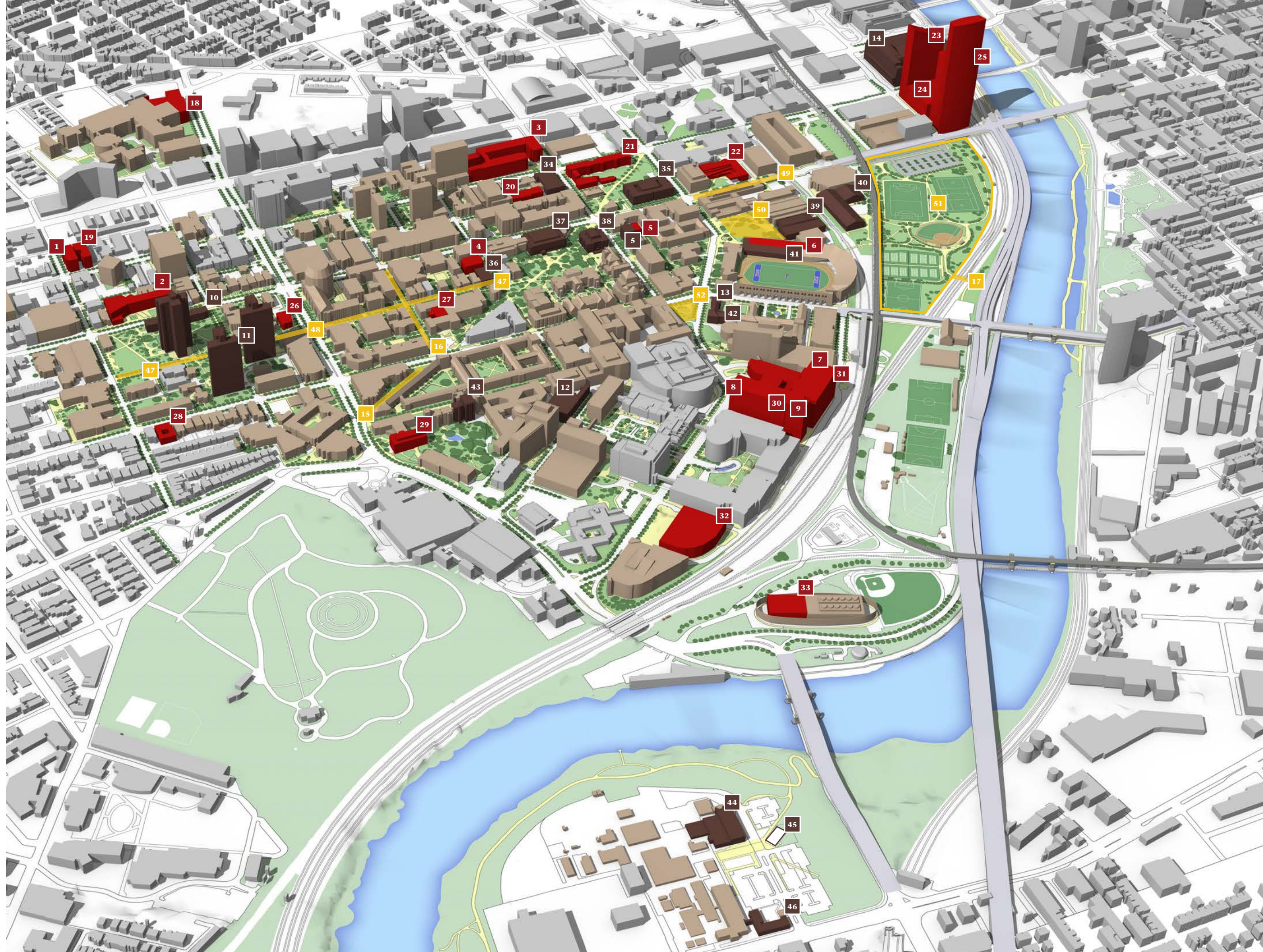
