

PennAccess: Steinberg Conference Center

Entrance Information:

255 South 38th Street. Philadelphia. PA. 19104

- 1. Both the east and west main entrances have push-plate-operated doors.
- 2. The entrance from Locust Walk on the northeast of the building is level and has two pairs of manual doors which open outward.
- 3. There is an accessible entrance between Steinberg Conference Center and Vance Hall that enters into the MBA Pub, but the manual door is heavy, narrow, and opens outward.
- Note: All exterior entrances are wheelchair accessible. The parking garage within the building has a ramp to the first floor lobby.

Elevator Information:

• There is a bank of two elevators in the middle of the building which accesses all areas of the building.

Accessible Restrooms:

• All public restrooms are accessible.

Building Information:

• The accessible guest rooms are rooms 304 and 306.

- Every conference room has an accessible route of entry, although the front or main entrance to the rooms may have stairs.The Aresty Institute of Executive Education is located within this building.
- Steinberg Conference Center is connected to the McNeil Building via an underground passage and service elevator.
- There is a designated accessible parking space located in the entrance driveway off 38th St.
