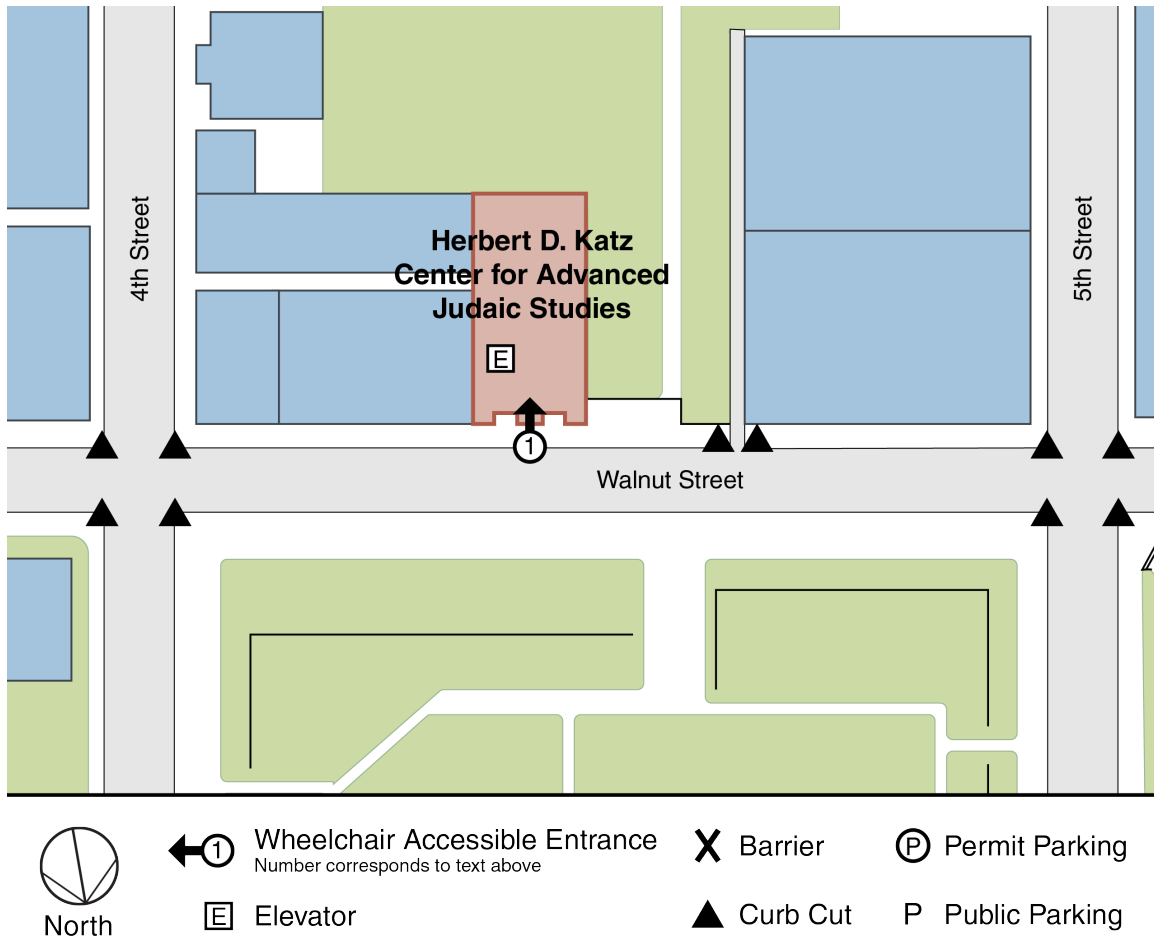


PennAccess: Katz Center for Advanced Judaic Studies, Herbert D.



Entrance Information:

420 Walnut Street. Philadelphia. PA. 19106

1. The accessible entrance is through the center doors at the main entrance on the north side of the building. This entrance is accessible from the sidewalk on Walnut St and is level with the sidewalk. The main elevator is accessible from the lobby.

Elevator Information:

- The main elevator accesses the sub-basement (B2) through Floor 6.
- The elevator in the rear of the building is card-access only for staff and accesses the sub-basement (B2) through Floor 3.

Accessible Restrooms:

- Floor 1: Accessible Single user restroom.
- Floors 2-6: Restroom with one accessible stall and one urinal.

Building Information:

- All visitors must enter through the front door at 420 Walnut Street. The front door is unlocked during regular business hours or accessed by PennCard after hours. Inside the vestibule, visitors may enter the lobby by PennCard or by ringing the video doorbell to the receptionist.

- The Katz Center is open 9am to 5pm Monday-Friday. The Library's hours are 9am-4:30pm. Hours are subject to change. Visitors should consult the Library's website for specific hours and to make an appointment: <https://katz.sas.upenn.edu/>
- Access to The Rare Book Room, Archives, B1 and B2 are for Katz Center and Library Staff only, no guests are permitted.
- Public access is limited to the Lobby on Floor 1 and the Library Reading Room on Floor 2, by appointment only.
- All offices, hallways, and 6th floor conference rooms are restricted access to Katz Center staff, fellows and invited guests only.
